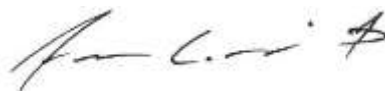
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2083 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2083 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2083 would require that the four legislative members of the Kansas Sentencing Commission be members of the Senate Judiciary Committee and the House of Representatives Corrections and Juvenile Justice Committee. Under current law, Commission members appointed by legislative leadership do not have to be members of specific committees.

The Kansas Sentencing Commission and the Kansas Legislative Coordinating Council indicate HB 2083 would have no fiscal effect.
