Chairwoman Williams and Members of Committee, thank you for holding this hearing and for the opportunity to provide testimony.

My name is Elizabeth Patton and I am the State Director of Americans for Prosperity—Kansas. On behalf of our activists all across our state, we urge you to support HB 2119, a bill which would expand educational opportunities for students in our state.

HB 2119 that would create an education savings account for children who are academically atrisk. Under the provisions of this bill, eligible students would receive an education scholarship account (ESA) to attend a school that best fits their unique educational needs, interests, and abilities – providing each student with the best foundation for an enriched life. Students would be able to use an ESA for a number of educational expenses, including tuition, fees, textbooks, tutoring services, curriculum, and other educational services.
