Subject: Bill Brief for HB 2473

House Bill 2473 removes the requirement that all district court judges in Douglas County serve on the board of trustees of the law library.

The bill amends K.S.A. 20-3127 concerning county law libraries. Current law allows the board of trustees of a law library in Johnson County and Sedgwick County to be made up of two district court judges and three members of the county's bar association but requires the board of trustees of a law library in any other county to be made up of all the district court judges in that county and no fewer than two attorneys in the county. This bill would apply the provisions that currently apply to Johnson and Sedgwick counties to Douglas County.
