


About KanREN











Anchor Institution Broadband Needs

It's not Just about bits per second anymore



The New Digital Divide

One Example: The Cloud (and what is the "cloud" really?)

• Cloud services involve moving something "off premises" and passing the responsibility of some portion of it to a 3rd party:



Software as a Service (SAAS) — You use the software, a 3rd party is responsible to keep it operating properly.



Platform as a Service (PAAS) — You still operate the software, usually one or more applications, but on an operating system that is managed by a 3rd party.



Infrastructure as a Service (IAAS) — A 3rd party operates and maintains the actual computing and/or storage hardware, You get to use that hardware as a service, maintaining the operating system and higher functions.

"Faster Internet" itself does not successfully enable many of these services



Please ensure the money that Kansas invests in Broadband Infrastructure creates both access and affordability for all services built with it, not just Internet service
