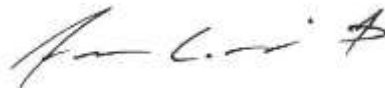
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2076 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2076 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2076 would require a person on surety bond who is arrested by the surety or the surety's designee to be returned to the county where the complaint subject to the bond was filed.

The Office of Judicial Administration states enactment of the bill would have a negligible fiscal effect on the operations of the Judicial Branch. The Kansas Association of Counties indicates enactment of HB 2076 would have a negligible fiscal effect on Kansas counties.
