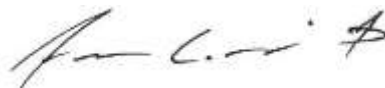
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 343 by Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 343 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 343 would update statutory terminology related to persons with hearing loss. Specifically, the term “hearing impairment” would be replaced by the term “hard of hearing.” The bill contains other technical adjustments.

Enactment of SB 343 would have no fiscal effect.
