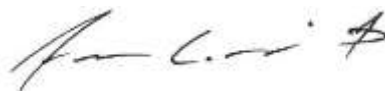
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 564 by Senate Committee on Assessment and Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 564 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 564 would require that lobbyists verbally disclose all litigation or other legal action being taken or pending against a client by any state agency that would be affected by proposed legislation when discussing the legislation with a legislator or when testifying before a committee considering the proposed legislation.

Legislative Administrative Services indicates the bill's enactment would not have a fiscal effect on the operations of the Legislature. The Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission states the bill would not have a fiscal effect on agency operations if enacted.
