Sec. 7. (a) Except as otherwise provided by this act, the director of
accounts and reports is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants on
the state treasurer in favor of the claimants specified in this act, upon
vouchers duly executed by the state agencies directed to pay the amounts
specified in such sections to the claimants or their legal representatives or
duly authorized agents, as provided by law.

10 (b) The director of accounts and reports shall secure prior to the 11 payment of any amount to any claimant, other than amounts authorized to 12 be paid pursuant to section 6 as motor-vehicle fuel tax refunds or as 13 transactions between state agencies as provided by this act, a written 14 release and satisfaction of all claims and rights against the state of Kansas 15 and any agencies, officers and employees of the state of Kansas regarding 16 their respective claims.

Sec. 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the Kansas register.
