## HOUSE BILL No. 2513

1 AN ACT concerning education; relating to the administration of certain 2 tests, questionnaires, surveys and examinations in schools; establishing 3 parental notification and written consent requirements; prohibiting the 4 incorporation of certain tests, questionnaires, surveys and examinations 5 into educational programs or curriculum; prohibiting collection of 6 personally identifiable student data; amending K.S.A. 72-6316 and 7 repealing the existing section.

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9 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

10 Section 1. K.S.A. 72-6316 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-11 6316. (a) No test, questionnaire, survey or examination containing any 12 questions about the student's personal and private attitudes, values, beliefs or practices on issues such as sex, family life, morality or religion, or any 13 questions about the student's parents' or guardians' beliefs and practices on 14 issues such as sex, family life, morality or religion, of the student or the 15 student's parents, guardians, family members, associates, friends or peers 16 shall be administered to any student enrolled in kindergarten or grades one 17 18 through 12, unless the parent or guardian of the student:

(1) Is notified in writing not more than four months in advance of the
 administration of such test, questionnaire, survey or examination that this
 such test, questionnaire, survey or examination is to be administered and
 the parent or guardian of the student. Such notification shall include:

(A) A copy of the test, questionnaire, survey or examination that is to
 be administered;

25 (*B*) information on how the parent or guardian may provide written 26 consent to authorize the student to take such test, questionnaire, survey or 27 examination;

(C) the name of the company or entity that produces or provides the
 test, questionnaire, survey or examination to the school;

30 *(D)* an explanation of the purpose of the data collection, how the 31 collected data is intended to be used and whether the data will remain 32 private or reported as aggregate data;

33 *(E)* an explanation of how such test, questionnaire, survey or 34 examination benefits student learning and academic achievement; and

35 *(F)* whether the school will receive or maintain the resulting data and 36 an explanation of how the school intends to use and maintain such data; 1 and

2 (2) gives written permission for consent through a written or electronic signature to authorize the student to take-this the test, 3 questionnaire, survey or examination. This section shall not prohibit-4 school counselors from providing counseling services to a student,-5 including the administration of tests and forms which are part of a 6 7 counselor's student counseling services. Any information obtained through 8 such tests or counseling services shall not be stored on any personalmobile electronic device which is not owned by the school district,-9 including but not limited to, laptops, tablets, phones, flash drives, external 10 hard drives or virtual servers. Such written consent may only be accepted 11 12 after a parent or guardian has received the notification required pursuant to paragraph (1) and had an opportunity to review the information 13 contained in such notification. Written consent shall be provided 14 15 separately for each individual test, questionnaire, survey or examination 16 that is to be administered.

(b) Notwithstanding a parent or guardian's written consent for a 17 student to take any such test, questionnaire, survey or examination, a 18 19 student shall have the right to refuse to take such test, questionnaire, survey or examination at any time without limitation. Prior to the 20 21 administration of any such test, questionnaire, survey or examination, 22 each student shall be informed that such student has the right to refuse to 23 take such test, questionnaire, survey or examination and that the student will not suffer any adverse consequences based on such refusal. 24

(c) Prior to the administration of any such test, questionnaire, survey
or examination, a school district shall post and maintain a copy of each
test, questionnaire, survey or examination on the school district website
until such time that the test, questionnaire, survey or examination is:

(1) No longer administered by the school district; or

30 (2) administered again at a later date or in a subsequent school year
31 and at which time, the school district shall update the website to provide
32 the current version that is to be administered by the school.

(d) No such test, questionnaire, survey or examination shall be
 incorporated or embedded in any academic program, course or
 curriculum offered or provided by a school district.

*(e)* No personally identifiable student data shall be collected through *any such test, questionnaire, survey or examination.*

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Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-6316 is hereby repealed.
