5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Any renewable energy facility in which energy 6 7 generated by such facility is utilized or procured by an electric public 8 utility for the provision of such utility's baseload generation supply shall 9 be required to have and make available alternative dispatchable electricity 10 generation sources that are capable of supplying 50% or more of such 11 renewable energy facility's nameplate capacity as backup baseload 12 generation supply for the electric public utility. The provision of such 13 alternative dispatchable generation sources shall be for electricity 14 generation resilience during extreme weather events or conditions that disrupt the operation of such renewable energy facilities. 15

(b) The state corporation commission may promulgate rules and
 regulations and issue any orders necessary to implement the provisions of
 this section.

(c) As used in this section:

(1) "Electric public utility" means the same as defined in K.S.A. 66101a, and amendments thereto.

(2) "Renewable energy facility" means any electric generation facility
that utilizes wind or solar resources and technologies to generate
electricity.
