WHEREAS, On May 3, 2020, Officer Michael Mosher was on his way to work when he witnessed a vehicular hit and run in Overland Park; and

WHEREAS, The driver of the vehicle confronted Officer Mosher with a firearm and both were killed in the shootout; and
