Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. Any reapportionment of state senatorial districts or state representative districts pursuant to section 1 of article 10 of the constitution of the state of Kansas shall be in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 4-101, and amendments thereto.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 4-101 is hereby amended to read as follows: 4-101. *On and after January 9, 2023,* the senate shall consist of forty 40 members, and the house of representatives *shall consist* of one hundred and twenty-five 120 members.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 4-101 is hereby repealed.

15 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
