AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates; 2 providing for the north central Kansas down syndrome society license 3 plate.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2023, any owner or lessee of 7 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 8 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with 9 the provisions of this section, may be issued one north central Kansas 10 down syndrome society license plate for each such passenger vehicle or 11 truck. Such license plate shall be issued for the same time as other license 12 plates upon proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as 13 provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and either the payment to the county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment or the presentation 14 of the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection 15 16 (b).

17 (b) The north central Kansas down syndrome society may authorize 18 the use of the organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as 19 provided by this section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may apply 20 annually to the north central Kansas down syndrome society for use of 21 such logo. Such owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not less than \$25 22 nor more than \$100 to the north central Kansas down syndrome society as 23 a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate to be issued. The 24 logo use royalty payment shall be paid to either:

25 (1) The north central Kansas down syndrome society, which shall 26 issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo 27 use authorization statement that shall be presented by the motor vehicle 28 owner or lessee at the time of registration; or

30 Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may (c) 31 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to such 32 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished 33 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall 34 either provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in 35 subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. 36 Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in
 a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms furnished by
 the director.

4 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be 5 transferable to any other person.

6 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer a north central Kansas down 7 syndrome society license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased 8 vehicle.

9 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually, 10 upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No renewal of 11 registration shall be made to any applicant until such applicant provides to 12 the county treasurer either the annual logo use authorization statement 13 provided for in subsection (b) or the payment of the annual royalty 14 payment. If such statement is not presented at the time of registration or 15 16 faxed by the north central Kansas down syndrome society, or the annual 17 royalty payment is not made to the county treasurer, the applicant shall be 18 required to comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments 19 thereto, and return the license plate to the county treasurer of such person's 20 residence.

(g) The north central Kansas down syndrome society shall provide to all county treasurers an electronic mail address where applicants can contact the north central Kansas down syndrome society for information concerning the application process or the status of such applicant's license plate application.

(h) The north central Kansas down syndrome society, with the
approval of the director of vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under
the provisions of this section.

(i) As a condition of receiving the order of the north central Kansas
down syndrome society license plate and any subsequent registration
renewal of such license plate, the applicant shall consent to the division
authorizing the division's release of motor vehicle record information,
including the applicant's name, address, royalty payment amount, plate
number and vehicle type, to the north central Kansas down syndrome
society and the state treasurer.

(j) The collection and remittance of annual royalty payments by the
county treasurer shall be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,141(h),
and amendments thereto.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
