Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of article 10 of chapter 82a of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, the holder of a water right dedicated to a beneficial use other than irrigation may elect to withdraw from a groundwater management district if the:

- (A) Point of diversion is located within such district; and
- 12 (B) authorized place of use is located wholly or partially within such district.
 - (2) Such holder may elect to withdraw from the district by providing written notice to the board of directors prior to June 30. Upon proper notice, such withdrawal shall be effective the following January 1.
 - (b) Upon the effective date of withdrawal, the withdrawn water right holder shall not be subject to:
 - (1) Water user charges, annual land assessments, any special assessments or any other taxes or fees levied by the district;
 - (2) review by the board of directors of the district of any matters related to the withdrawn holder's water right or rights; and
- 23 (3) any rules and regulations adopted by the chief engineer that are specific to the district.
 - (c) Withdrawal from a district pursuant to this section shall not exempt the withdrawn holder from compliance with all other statutes and rules and regulations.
 - Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
