RE: Senate Bill 462

Thank you, Chairman Petersen, and Committee members, for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony for SB 462. This bill amends the language in K.S.A. 8-2, 133.

The amended language would allow qualified military drivers to waive the knowledge test when obtaining a CDL. Combined with the current statutorily authorized skills test waiver, this legislation would allow a qualified driver to exchange a military license for a CDL. This legislation would help increase the pool of qualified CDL holders.

The Division of Vehicles currently accepts military even exchange applicants and this legislation would merely codify what is already an existing Division of Vehicles practice.
