This is an increase of \$7.5 million from all funds, or 15.0 percent, including a decrease of \$60,235 SGF, or 0.3 percent, below the FY 2024 approved amount. The agency's revised estimate includes an increase of \$3.4 million from federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for Local Safety and Security Equipment (LSSE) grants and the addition of \$4.1 million for adjustments to various other federal grant funds. The request includes an increase of 0.5 FTE position to manage the LSSE grants.
