The Chairman stated the agenda listed a hearing on **HB 2372 - Misclassifying employees as independent contractors to avoid withholding income tax, class A nonperson misdemeanor; investigation by department of revenue.** Instead of holding a hearing on the bill the Floor will be open for bill introductions.

Representative Ruff requested a bill similar to **HB 2202** but with added improvements.

The Chairman stated without exception the bill will be accepted.

Representative Ruff requested a bill requesting a study by the Department of Insurance of possible fraud or abuse by some carriers in regard to employers in Kansas.

There was objection to the request.

The Chairman stated that since there was objection the proposed bill would not be accepted as a committee bill.

Representative Holland requested introduction of a bill similar to **HB 2372** but with modified language.

The Chairman stated without exception the bill will be accepted.

Hal Hudson requested introduction of a bill commonly that is now known as the Small Business Flexibility Act.

The Chairman stated without exception the bill will be accepted.

Sherry C. Diel, Executive Director, Kansas Real Estate Board, requested a bill concerning real estate brokers and salespersons; relating to expiration, suspension, revocation of licenses and civil fines.

The Chairman stated without exception the bill will be accepted.
